GIFT AID DECLARATION FORM

Any subscription / donation made to a charity by an individual paying UK tax can be treated as a Gift Aid. This means that the **society** can reclaim the tax you have already paid on amounts you pay to the society as a subscription or donation. Currently we can reclaim 25p on every £1.00 paid, thus increasing the value to the Society (e.g. we can reclaim £6.25 for a £25.00 subscription). **You** may also be able to reclaim tax if you are paying at the Higher Tax rate - see note 3 below.

This new system is easy to set up: all you need to do is print off this form, complete your name and address, tick the following statement, sign, date and return the form.

Notes:-

- 1. Your declaration will cover any donation you are kind enough to make in the future. Please therefore notify us if you change your name or address.
- 2. You can cancel this declaration at any time by letting us know in writing. You may need to do this if your tax status changes.
- 3. If you pay tax at the higher rate, you can claim further tax relief in your self-assessment return.
- 4. In order for the scheme to apply, you must ensure that you pay an amount of income tax, and/or capital gains tax equal to that which we will reclaim (currently 25p in each £1 you give).
